Apprentice positions for youth 15-18 years of age

Qualifications:

- Must be Army or DoD Civilian teen, ages 15-18 years.
- Must currently be registered with Child, Youth & School (CYS) Services.
- Currently attending high school (proof required).
- Must currently possess and maintain a 2.0 grade-point-average or better throughout HIRED! Apprenticeship term (proof required).
- Satisfactory completion of local police background check.

Overview of Program:

The HIRED! Apprenticeship Program is a workforce-preparation and apprenticeship enterprise designed to meet the employment and career-exploration needs of Army, and DoD Civilian teens 15-18 years of age.

* **HIRED! Apprenticeship Terms** consist of four (4) twelve (12) week terms repeated annually. Participants 15-18 years of age are able to participate in a maximum of (2) terms per year for three (3) consecutive years. Within each twelve (12) week term, apprentices are expected to work fifteen (15) hours in a seven (7) day period while participating in HIRED!-training workshops (total of 180 hours). Upon successful completion of each HIRED! Term, the apprentices are eligible for a "Cash Award" through CYS Services.
