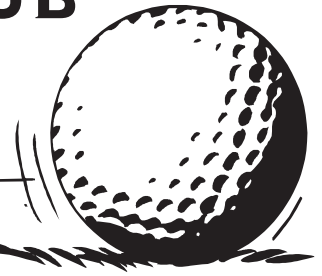

GET GOLF READY

Your FJGC PGA professionals are excited to offer eight "Get Golf Ready" sessions in 2010. Fort Jackson Golf Club is recognized as a Certified Get Golf Ready facility. This program was developed by the PGA of America and is focused on introducing new players to the game of golf. The program includes six hours of instruction by PGA professionals and four hours of supervised play on the course designed to make players comfortable playing the game. Each Get Golf Ready session is limited to 16 participants. Due to the limited class size, each participant will receive a significant amount of personal instruction from the two PGA professionals assigned to each class. All sessions consist of six classes over a three-week period. The fee for the Get Golf Ready program is ONLY \$99. All equipment and range balls are included in the fee. ON THE COURSE...

Could spring be just around the corner? We all hope that this winter will end soon and we can get back to what we love to do PLAY GOLF. The extended winter has allowed the greens staff to complete many projects such as drainage in # 1 and # 10 fairway Old Hickory and numerous under brushing projects. We are all ready to see the green grass. Last week we got back to the tasks at hand with mowing the greens and looking at their progress. Good news and not so good news: Good stuff first - we cut some plugs out of the greens and brought them into the shop to enhance the growth in the warm indoor temperatures, and within a couple of days the tiny green shoots started to appear. Over two weeks later we took soil temperature readings and we are at 60 degrees and have good growth. The not so good news is that we placed the soil thermometer in a couple of the greens and the temperature was 39 degrees. I guess you could say the soil thermometer could replace the groundhog, and we have just a little bit of winter to go when it comes to growing turf. It isn't as bad as it seems; the 21-degree variance does close in fast when the night time temperatures increase above freezing. We haven't seen the above freezing night time temperatures much of this winter.

The greens staff has done a great job this winter in accomplishing the dreaded winter tasks that get the course prepared for the spring excitement, creating new views from the under brushing efforts to painting the trash cans and ball washers, and even remodeling the rain shelters. The winter weeds have been controlled well and the course is extremely clean and should help prompt good Bermuda growth when the time comes.

The greens staff would like to say special congratulations to Mike Casto for his recent election to become the Vice President of the Carolinas PGA Section. Mike is well respected in the Carolinas Golf Industry and will represent Fort Jackson Golf Club well along with the PGA Section.

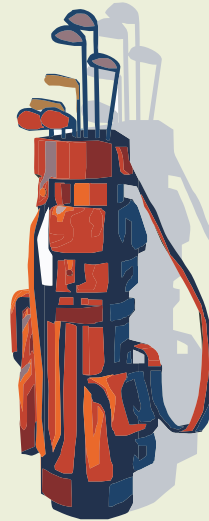

Great work everyone and congratulations to each of you on your Great Shot. Please take a moment to report all great and/or unusual accomplishments so we can include them in the next "Tee Times."


RANGE CLUB

Is your goal for 2010 to lower your handicap? If so, consider a membership in the FJGC Range Club. A yearly membership to the Range Club is only \$200.00. Each additional Family member can be added to a Range Club Membership for an additional \$25 per person.

Each Range Club member will be issued two range ball bags. Before each practice session, simply return your empty bags to the Golf Shop and exchange them for two full bags. Any lost or missing bags can be replaced for a \$5.00 charge.

We would like to remind ALL Range Club members that your range balls are for your personal use only and cannot be shared with another person.

We also ask that you NOT keep filled bags of range balls in your vehicle. The storage of balls in your vehicle greatly REDUCES the number of balls available to our patrons. In turn, this requires us to collect balls off the range more frequently and increases our labor costs. Of course, increased costs will be passed along to all of our customers!

EIGHT STEPS FOR FASTER PLAY...

1. Play "ready" golf ... this means that the person who's ready hits when it's safe. Establish this process with your group on the first tee.
2. To save time, always have a provisional ball in your pocket.
3. Pay close attention to the shots of the other players in your group and help "spot" their ball. Visually mark where their ball lands with a fixed landmark.
4. Pick up your ball after you have taken more than 8-10 strokes on a hole.
5. Always be ready to play when it is your turn and bring extra clubs with you in preparation for whatever shot you face.
6. Anticipate your next shot. Bring your putter and chipping club so you can proceed directly to the green to putt.
7. Park your cart or place your bag close to the next tee so you don't have to backtrack to get it.
8. Mark your score on the next tee box, not on or near the green of the hole you just completed.



PROPER ATTIRE REMINDER...

For men, collared shirts or a sport shirt is required when playing golf at FJGC.

Women may wear collared shirts or sleeves, blouses with broad straps across the shoulders.

T-shirts, cut-offs, tank tops or similar attire is prohibited. For first time visitors, some leniency is provided in order to assure that their first visit to FJGC is a positive one.
