### Research Anywhere, Anytime!

Can't make it to the library? We are bringing the library to you! All library research databases are available to you wherever you have the access to the Internet.

### 3 ways to get there:

- Just click on the "Research" tab next to your "My Account" tab.
- Find all Online Library Resources in AKO:  
*\*Logging in via AKO is the only place to find ALL of the downloadable eAudio and eBooks for your MP3, iPOD, iPAD etc.*
  1. Log into your AKO account at [www.us.army.mil](http://www.us.army.mil).
  2. Click on Self Service.
  3. Click on My Library.

### Example Fort Jackson-only Access Databases Include:

**Nineteenth Century U.S. Newspapers** - provides digital images of both full pages and clipped articles for hundreds of 19th century U.S. newspapers. Researchers will be able to research history in ways previously unavailable. For each issue, the newspaper is captured from cover-to-cover, providing access to every article, advertisement and illustration.

**Great for genealogists!**

**Declassified Documents Reference System** - provides online access to over 500,000 pages of previously classified government documents. Covering major international events from the Cold War to the Vietnam War and beyond. This single source enables users to locate key information in international relations, American studies, United States foreign and domestic policy studies, journalism and more.

### Sort Results

You can sort by title, author, publication year, reverse publication year, call number, and material type.

### More Search Options

Narrow your search with easy to use advanced keyword search options. Search just for movies, CDs, books, and more.

### Limit Search to Available Items

Want to know what you can get immediately at the library? Click on "Limit search to available items." This will show you items that are available to be checked out right now.

## My Account Features

You can now manage your library account from anywhere at anytime! Go to the US Army Libraries Web site and log in with your e-mail address today!

To set up your account:

1. Go to your library's web address.  
Find your library at:  
<http://mylibraryus.fmwr.net>
2. Click on "My Account" tab
3. Click on "get a PIN"
4. Enter your e-mail address and leave "PIN" blank
5. You will receive an e-mail with a link. This link expires in 3 hours.
6. From the link, you can assign your own PIN
7. PINs must be numeric and 4-6 digits long.

*Note: You must first be registered at a GLIS library and have provided a unique e-mail address (no one else in the library system has it, such as a spouse or child). If you do not have a unique e-mail address, ask the library staff about our MWR Card option. Please remember that email addresses are required in order to be notified of items placed on hold etc.*

### Make Requests



You can make requests for items at anytime online. If the item is checked-out to another patron, you will be placed on the waiting list. We advise calling the library to request a staff member pull the item from the shelf if the item status is "available" in the catalog. An email will be sent when your items are ready for pick-up. Items are held for 7 days (2 days if other requests exist beyond yours).

### Check Your Account Status



Use "My Account" to view your borrowed items, due dates and request statuses.

### Renew Checked Out Items



You may renew your items online as long as no one else has a request on it or you have reached your max of 3 renewals.

## Create Personal Reading Lists



Create a "wish list" to help manage the list of movies you want to see or books you want to read. You can also make a list to keep a bibliography for research or homework.

## Keep a Reading History



The library does not keep a history of what you have checked out, but you can access your own "history." Opt in to start a history of items you have checked out (and opt out at any time) for your own personal use. With this feature, you can also limit your searches to not show items you have already checked out.

## My Searches



Instead of re-typing a popular search, just save it! We will remember the search for you. Not only that, if you check "mark for email," every Monday we will send you an e-mail list of any new items that match your search query.

## Ratings & Reviews



Share your opinions or read other patron reviews.

## Rate Items



Not interested in writing about an item but feel like sharing your opinion of it anyway? Give it a star rating from 1 to 5.
