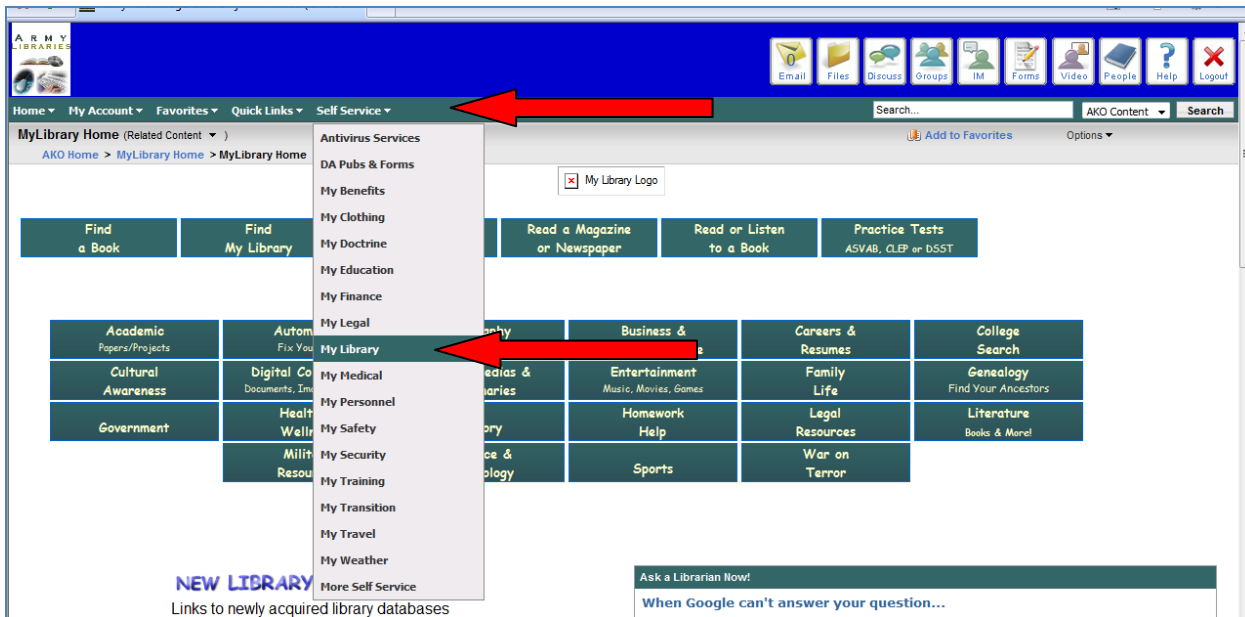


DOWNLOADABLE eBOOKS AND eAUDIO BOOKS!

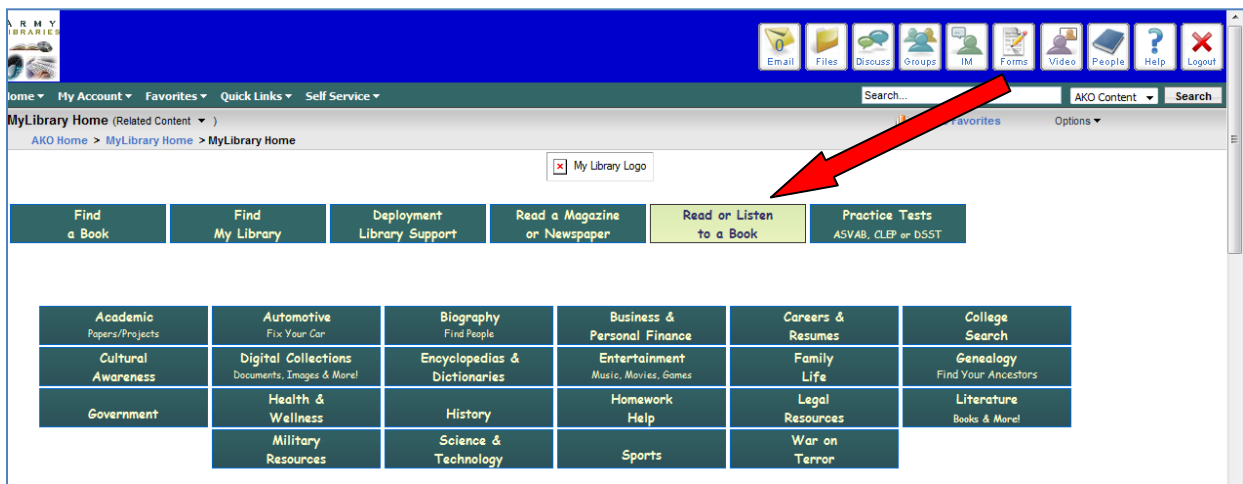
1. Go to AKO Account
