PARTICIPATION



- Bde/Bn//Tenants/Battalions or equivalent size units/organizations can volunteer in three ways:
 - (a) Bde/Bn//Tenants or equivalent size units and organizations can adopt a specific school and complete volunteer activities within that school on a regular basis.
 - (b) Bde/Bn//Tenants or equivalent size units and organizations can chose from multiple schools for activities that fit into the mission time requirements.
 - (c) Soldier(s) can chose to volunteer for different activities in the school. (Soldier(s) must get supervisor's approval for use of mission time.) Soldier(s) will make arrangements with schools POC.

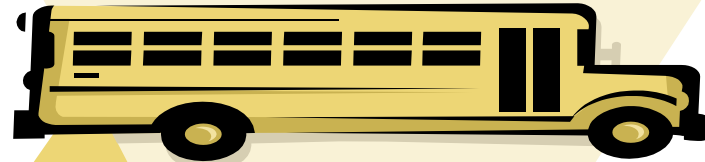
